CONTENT AREA: English & Literature

TOPIC: Story Plot

MATERIALS:

- Podcast, Episode 1
- Security Folder
- PLOT REPORT FORM
- SUMMARY:

Mysterious tracks were found by Drover and JT Cluck in the dirt. Hank sets out to figure out who left the prints and mistakenly believes they are from a raccoon or Pete the Barncat. - <u>Plot:</u> A plot is simply the events that happen in a story. The author puts different events in an order based on the plot. A plot is made of different parts and events. Understanding a character and what he or she does is easier when we understand the plot and its different parts.
- <u>Rising Action:</u> the events that happen at the beginning, before the turning point.
- <u>Conflict Problem:</u> the problem that is faced by a character or characters.
- <u>Climax/turning point:</u> the part of the plot in which the events are the most exciting.
- <u>Resolution</u>: the final part of the plot in which the problem is solved.

4. Have Students Complete RANCH SECURITY PLOT REPORT FORM based on the story from episode 1.

- Security Folder

LET'S GET STARTED!

- 1. Listen to Podcast Episode 1.
- 2. Deputize your students –they are official Ranch Security Deputies. In order to solve the case, they must complete official reports to organize clues, examine suspects, and dismiss red herrings! Each student will receive an official case file folder(example included.) All reports will be completed and stored in the folder.
- 3. Review Parts of a Mystery

The same as story plot, (Activity 1) plus:

- Detective, in this case Hank is the protagonist.
- Sidekick
- Suspects: antagonist, motives, alibis
- The problem is the crime or mystery to be solved
- Clues these are events that are part of the rising action
- Red Herrings misleading clues (they are meant to throw the reader off)

4. Tell students that as a class you will be using the mystery plot diagram to map out the podcast series. After each podcast episode, you can work as a class to add to the diagram. You may want to have students staple their diagram to the front or back of their folder for easy access.

5. Put it all together at the end of each episode, then help them put it all together at the end. Maybe section it out. For example: Is there a mystery within a mystery, within a mystery? Teacher fills out MYSTERY PLOT DIAGRAM with the group as a class.


INSTRUCTIONS:



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ACTIVITY 4

Hankisms

CONTENT AREA: English & Literature

TOPIC: Vocabulary

MATERIALS:

- Podcast, Episode 1
- Episode 1 Script
- Whiteboard

SUMMARY:

Mysterious tracks were found by Drover and JT Cluck in the dirt. Hank sets out to figure out who left the prints and mistakenly believes they are from a raccoon or Pete the Barncat. Unfortunately for Hank, the prints belong to Sinister the Bobcat. Hank and Sinister get into a brawl and Hank, defeated, limps back to his gunnysack.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Students will be able to determine the meaning of words and phrases in the podcast.

LET'S GET STARTED! 1. Listen to Podcast Episode

2. Introduction:

The story is told in first person by Hank the Cowdog. Hank uses a western dialect and some made up words. The author used words like fellers, raccoon, nosatory, and humilification. As they listen, have students identify words like these. The author also includes humorous sayings such as, "chickens don't know beans about tracks." Write the following on the board:

• <u>"I can figure out the meaning of tricky words using sentence level context for support!"</u>


<u>3. Display the Vocabulary Strategies Chart (See next page for example) and use the following terms to practice using the strategies:</u>


Track Analysis

For Offical Use by Ranch Security Deputies

On the ranch, you might not see many wild animals, but you can see the tracks they leave behind. To be a good Ranch Security Deputy, you need to be able to look for tracks and identify what animals left them. Mammals in the dog and cat familes walk on four toes. You can see claws in dog's prints, but not in cats. Bears, raccoons, and rodents walk on five toes. Some animals have human-like hands, and other have hooves.



Trait #1	Scared	"Drover's quivers turned to shakes and he nearly fell over in place as we watched Sinister disapper"
Trait #2	Smart	Drover knows the baby isn't a lizard. "It's just a baby Hank."
Trait #3	Cautious	When Prover senses trouble he runs away. "The runt had abandoned me."
Trait #4	Worried	Prover keeps thinking about the tracks, even when Hank falls alseep. "Hank? Left with nothing but snores, Prover sighs. Sure doesnt; look like a raccoon track to me."
